This unique presentation of the Gospel is the result of the work of many TCKF Trustees over many years, with the assistance of pastors, evangelists, missionaries and artists. The final selection process was guided by Biblical scholar, Dr. Robby Carpenter, DDS of Kerrville, TX. Artist/evangelist, Max Greiner, Jr. and his wife, Sherry were first called by God on December 9, 2001, to establish free Sculpture Prayer Gardens across the world, to bring glory and souls to Jesus Christ.

These scriptures have been sandblasted on 77, 16" ceramic Scripture Tiles, in three languages, at THE COMING KING SCULPTURE PRAYER GARDEN. This free garden park, which is located on IH-10 in Kerrville, TX, is the prototype for other proposed evangelistic gardens. The Scripture Tiles are placed every 12', in a 300' cross-shaped garden, which has a massive, 77'7" Cor-ten steel sculpture called "The Empty Cross" as its focal point. Believed to be the most symbolic cross sculpture in the world, the blood colored, reddish brown cross symbolizes the Resurrection, the Blood, the Strong Tower, the Mighty Fortress, the Narrow Gate, the Door, the Way and the Light of the World.
